Unfortunately, we are unable to complete a comprehensive educational plan during our drop-in hours, however, we can set you up with a one hour counseling appointment if you'd like a comprehensive educational plan.

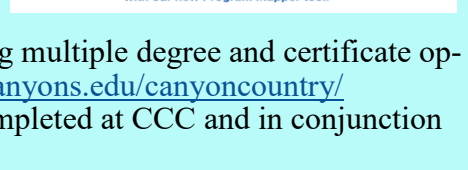
Will you be graduating with your associate degree this Spring 2023?
Stop by the Counseling Office to submit your graduation petition. If you submit your graduation petition by November 1st, you'll be eligible for priority enrollment for spring registration! The deadline to petition for Spring 2023 is February 10, 2023.

Will you be earning your Certificate of Achievement or Certificate of Specialization this Fall 2022?
Stop by the Counseling office to submit your petition for your certificate. The deadline is the end of the term, December 10, 2022.

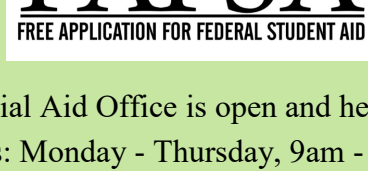

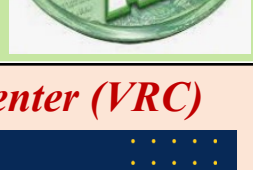
Get ready to apply for the 2023-2024 FAFSA application. You can apply as early as October 1st at www.fafsa.gov.

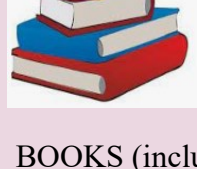
