



### **Head Coach Chris Cota**

Chris Cota began his career at College of the Canyons as right fielder for the Cougars in 1985 and 1986. He starred on the 1986 squad that won the state championship, the last COC team to accomplish that feat.

In 1986, he was drafted and signed by the Chicago White Sox. He wound up playing four seasons in the White Sox and California Angels organizations.

He served as an assistant coach under longtime head coach Len Mohney for 10 years before he was named as Mohney's replacement after the 2000 season.

In the past nine seasons, Cota has amassed a 213-163-2 record and has captured the Western State Conference title four times, in 2003, 2004, 2008 and 2009. In all of those seasons, Cota was also named WSC Coach of the Year.

College of the Canyons baseball has a rich history of triumph in Santa Clarita Valley. The Cougars have won three state championships (1981, 1983, 1986) and 22 conference titles, including the most recent in 2008 and 2009. COC's baseball program has also been a breeding ground for talent among coaches and players that have gone on to successful careers. The Cougars first head coach, Mike Gillespie, spent 20 years as the leader at USC and is now at UC Irvine. Oakland Athletics starting pitcher Dana Eveland got his start with COC before being drafted. In the past five years, 11 Cougars have been drafted in the MLB draft.
