College of the Canyons Volleyball Camp



The College of the Canyons Volleyball Camp is designed for boys and girls ages 9-16 and will introduce beginning volleyball players to the basic skills of the sport, including:

- *servicing*
- *passing*
- *setting*
- *attacking/hitting*
- *blocking*
- *digging*

More experienced players will have the opportunity to fine-tune

their basic skills and learn more advanced ones including:

- *offensive and defensive concepts*
- *the quick attack*
- *jump serving*

All campers will receive individualized instruction as well as opportunities to play in game-like settings.

The camp will provide players a fun and challenging environment to develop and improve their skills. Campers will be grouped according to age, experience and gender.

The camp will run July 28-31 and Aug. 3-6 from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm each day. **For an additional fee, lunch is available.**



The camp is staffed by the coaches and players of the College of the Canyons volleyball program. The Cougars won the Western State Conference Western Division titles in both 1999 and 2000. They have finished each of the last 10 seasons ranked in the top 20 in the state. In 2007, the program made its first ever appearance in the state tournament.

LISA HOOPER Camp Co-Director

Lisa earned her bachelor's degree in nutrition from Pepperdine University, and immediately began her teaching career. She earned her master's degree in Exercise Science from Long Beach State. She is a graduate of nearby Canyon High School where she was an All-Golden League, All-CIF, and All-Santa Clarita Valley player. She has been head of the College of the Canyons volleyball team for 12 years and is two-time Western State Conference Coach of the Year. Lisa and the Cougars had their best season in 2007 as they upset the two-time state champions, Orange Coast, and the No. 1 team in California, Irvine Valley, for the program's first bid to the state championship tournament.



CLAY TIMMONS Camp Co-Director

Clay is entering his fifth year as assistant coach at College of the Canyons. He took a year off from coaching in 2006 after he was a volunteer coach in 2004 and an assistant for the Cougars in 2005. Clay graduated from Valencia High School in 2003 where he was a member of the 2003 CIF Championship volleyball team. He is currently attending California State University, Northridge.
