## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

**What services are available on campus?** The goal of the Canyon Country Campus is to provide our students with similar services offered at the Valencia Campus. For a list of campus support services/ departments and hours check out the service schedule online at [Service Hours](#).

**Do I need a parking permit?** Student parking permits are required each day until 2:00 pm. Students must always park in student lots. Semester permits may be purchased **ONLINE ONLY** through your MyCanyons account. When you purchase your permit online a 10-day temporary parking permit will be sent to you via email for use until your permanent permit can be delivered. Instructions for purchasing parking permits online can be found at [Parking](#). Daily permits may be purchased for \$3.00/day from the black vending machines located at the entrance of Lots 1 and 2 and in front of the building 1A in Lot 3.

**Where can I get a student ID card?** Student ID cards can be made in the ASG Computer Lounge (room 204).

**Where can I print on campus?** Printers are available for student use in the Library (307), TLC (306), Student Study Room (302), ASG Student Lounge (204) and Student Services Computer Lab (building 1B). Print cards can be purchased in TLC (306) or the Student Study Room (302).

**Is there an ATM on campus?** Yes, an ATM is available in the Vending Café in room 303. The Vending Cafe is open Monday - Thursday 7:30am - 9:00pm and Friday 7:30am - 4:00pm.

**Are there food services available on campus?** The Canyons Café, located on Cougar Way, sells a variety of sandwiches, salads, smoothies, coffee and other snacks Monday - Thursday 7:30am - 7:00pm. Sodas, water, chips and snacks are also available from the vending machines in the Vending Cafe in room 303 Monday - Thursday 7:30am - 9:00pm and Fridays 7:30am - 4:00pm.

**Is there a bookstore on campus?** We currently do not have a bookstore at the Canyon Country Campus, however books can be ordered online and shipped to your home for free using promo code **BNCFREESHIP**. Scantrons and Blue Books can be purchased in the Vending Café (Room 303).
