

## Nuts, Bolts & Thingamajigs Summer Camp

July 23-27, 2018

Welcome!

This is going to be an exciting five days! To start, the campers will be working in a real live welding & metal fabrication laboratory using many of today's welding processes (including Virtual Welding)! They will cut, drill, and shape metal into various projects using equipment such as drill presses, metal lathes, horizontal mills, plasma cutters and more! Assigned metal projects will be completed using acquired skills in conjunction with specified welding & cutting and fabrication equipment. Campers will also learn about applying basic entrepreneurship principles to understand how a single product idea becomes a business. Some important information you need to know before camp:

1. Please make sure you have filled out and submitted the District emergency contact form and liability waiver prior to the start of the camp. If under 18, the parent/guardian will need to complete both forms. Campers will not be able to participate if both completed forms are not received.
2. Dress code – Campers **MUST** wear sturdy work boots – leather is preferred. Campers **MUST** also wear long pants for protection. They will be working with real welding equipment. This is for their protection. All additional safety materials will be provided.
3. Drop off & Pick up – If campers will be dropped off and/or picked up please do so at lot 13 near the access road just behind Towsley Hall. If they will be driving themselves, please park in lot 13. A parking permit will be provided to on the first day of class. Please let the instructor know that you need one. Campers will be required to sign in and out each day. If they have not signed in by 9:30 AM each day, a phone call will be made to the parent/guardian.
4. Location – Camp is being held in the Welding & Metal Fabrication Laboratory on the Valencia Campus. This is located in Towsley Hall room 120 (see campus map).
5. Food – We will be supplying lunch. We **cannot** accommodate special food request. If you have special food needs, please plan accordingly. There are soda and water vending machines on campus but access will be limited. You will get hot. Campers will also want to bring bottled water or a drink for the day.
6. Camp hours are from 9:00AM – 3:00PM, July 23-27, 2018 (M-F).
