Topics include the principles and features of ICS, organizational overview, incident facilities, incident resources, and common responsibilities.

**FIRETC 202 I-300 INTERMEDIATE (ICS) INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM**

For fire personnel who have an intermediate-level requirement for understanding the Incident Command System. A continuation of ICS training for members of a wildland fire incident team. REGISTRATION IS LIMITED TO STUDENTS WHO HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED PROGRAM PREREQUISITES.

**FIRETC “L” SERIES**

Units: .25 – 11.00

Variable format depending on subject matter. Course content includes refresher material from all areas related to ocean lifeguard employment, operation, service.
