Army Reservists & GI Bill Eligibility Update The Department of the Army recently announced that they are now counting Active Duty Training (ADT), Active Duty Special Work (ADSW), and Active Duty Operational Support-Reserve Component (ADOS-RC) performed under section 12301(d) of title 10, United States Code, after September 10, 2001 as qualifying service for the Post-9/11 GI Bill. As a result, **certain individuals may gain eligibility for Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits, be eligible to receive additional benefits as a result of a higher eligibility level (%), or establish eligibility for Transfer of Education Benefits (TEB).**

Army Reserve Soldiers should review their ADT, ADSW, and ADOS-RC in the Reserve Component Manpower System (RCMS) self-service site or contact their Unit Administrator, S-1, or Reserve Personnel Administration Center to ensure that service is reflected accurately. Those impacted will not need to reapply with VA for benefits. Corrections to service should be automatically transferred to VA and reviewed when beneficiary enrollments and/or applications are submitted for processing.
