SCORE which stands for Santa Clarita's Opportunity for a Recreational Experience relies on funding from community members and generous business and non-profit donors to help meet the needs and fulfill the requests of local families.

## Application Deadlines

All **SCORE** applications submitted for classes/programs listed in the **Seasons** brochure will be accepted during the following dates:

WINTER 2018 - Application submission period: Monday, October 23 – Friday, November 3, 2017  
Notification week of November 6 – 10, 2017 (Online registration begins November 14, 2017)

SPRING 2018 - Application submission period: Monday, January 29 –Friday, February 9, 2018  
Notification week of February 12 – 16, 2018 (Online registration begins February 20, 2018)

## Eligibility

Any resident within the City of Santa Clarita boundaries is eligible to apply for a SCORE scholarship for a child/dependent (17 years of age and under) in their household who meet the eligibility guidelines and provide all necessary documents within the open enrollment period.
