CONVERSATIONAL AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE FOR COLLEGE AND CAREER CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

The two-course certificate is geared for anyone who wants to increase American Sign Language fluency. These classes were designed to augment learning for students in credit ASL courses but anyone with sign language skills is welcome. NC. SIGN-005 is designed for students with basic knowledge of ASL. NC.SIGN-006 is designed for students with advanced knowledge of ASL or enrolled in SIGN-103 and above.

NC.SIGN-005 BEGINNING CONVERSATIONAL ASL FOR COLLEGE & CAREER

Recommended Preparation: Basic Knowledge of ASL Focuses on expressive and receptive skills in American Sign Language for college and career, while providing students additional development in conversational proficiency planning experiences, asking questions, and storytelling. Field trips may be required.

NC.SIGN-006 ADVANCED CONVERSATIONAL ASL FOR COLLEGE & CAREER

Recommended Preparation: NC.SIGN-005 Focuses on advanced expressive and receptive skills in American Sign Language for college and career, while providing students additional development in conversational proficiency in explaining personal experiences, participating in debates, and providing instructions. Field trips may be required.

NC.SIGN-002 INTRO TO ASL FOR FAMILY & COMMUNITY 1B

Prerequisite: NC.SIGN-001 Continuation of NC.SIGN-001

Additional courses not required for the certificate. Designed for parents, family, employers, and community members to learn ASL.

NC.SIGN-001 INTRO TO ASL FOR FAMILY & COMMUNITY 1A

Presents the fundamentals of ASL. Students develop expressive and receptive language skills through the learning of basic vocabulary, grammatical structures, and cultural awareness.


