## **Student Business Office**

It's officially springtime, but not until you take advantage of your spring break. But first, a few reminders from the Student Business Office:

Any student account that hasn't been paid in full has received a hold. In order to release the hold, we strongly advise students to pay their fess as soon as possible. To Pay: In your My Canyons account, on the Student menu click on My Billing and select Student Finance – Billing, Fees and Payments. All balances due will be displayed.

The Student Business Office processes third-party student sponsorship accounts. Do you have a third party, DOR, government agency, employer or insurance company that has agreed to pay your tuition? If so, you can set up a third-party billing so that you do not have to pay upfront and we will directly bill your sponsor. To set up a sponsorship, you will need to submit a Student Sponsorship Agreement Form requesting that we invoice your sponsor following registration and a financial guarantee from your sponsor detailing what fees are covered. Additionally, all refunds are issued at the end of each semester for any classes that were dropped before the refund deadline.
