PLUS:

- ◆ a minimum 2.0 grade point average (C average) or better in associate degree applicable units and be in good standing at College of the Canyons (all courses required for the major must be completed with a C grade or better).

NOTE: Students are NOT required to complete COC local degree requirements in Diversity, American Institutions and PE/Wellness. However it is recommended that students complete the American Institutions courses as part of either CSUGE or CSU-IGETC certification as CSU requires these for the Bachelors Degree.
