Antelope Valley Transitional Resource Center is located at the Lancaster work source center, 1420 W. Avenue I, Lancaster, CA 93534, 661-948-5763. The drop in center is available as a support system for emancipated foster youth that remain eligible for ILP services until their 21st birthday as well as youth preparing to emancipate.

This Drop-In Center Provides

- Access to on-site resources such as, Health care center, Teen support programs, Computer lab and Nutrition education (WIC)
