Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice

Costs: Tuition undergraduate \$470 per unit; undergraduate online classes \$470 per unit; Application Fee \$50 – waived with online application; Graduation Fee \$40.

Units: 120 Semester units needed for any bachelor’s degree. 36 Credits (12 classes) earned in Upper Division coursework; 32 credits (about 11 courses) must be in residence with a minimum of 18 credits upper division and 12 credits in the student’s major

Estimated Courses: Approx 40 courses. Will vary depending on pre-requisite program requirements and courses the student will be transferring. To be determined by UC partner.
