Alpha Mu Gamma is the National Collegiate Foreign Language Honor Society of the United States, founded in 1931. More than 300 charters in public and private universities and colleges have been granted in the United States. At COC, our chapter is Kappa XI.

Alpha Mu Gamma has as its primary purpose the honoring of students for outstanding achievement early in their college foreign language studies. However, students may be admitted at any stage of their college studies.

Activities of the society are: publication of the quarterly newsletter; biennial national conventions, at which students are able to meet others who share their interest in foreign languages; Alpha chapter meetings and special chapter activities of every sort; eligibility for member scholarships; notation in transcript, and the sponsorship of National Foreign Language Week.

<u>Eligibility:</u> Applicants must have a 3.0 Overall Grade Point Average and have earned 2 A's in the same foreign language at the college level. <u>Cost:</u> \$30.00 (Life-time membership)
