# What is Distance Education?



## Distance Education Defined

BP 4233(Attendance) defines DE as "courses that deliver instruction online using the Internet (synchronously and/or asynchronously), provide for regular and substantive contact and interaction online between instructor and students that is initiated by the instructor, and require online activities as part of a student's grade."



## Distance Education Defined

#### Title V

- "Education that uses one or more ... technologies ... to deliver instruction to students who are separated from the instructor(s) and to support regular and substantive interaction between the students and instructor(s) either synchronously or asynchronously."
- "A correspondence course is not distance education."

## Distance Education and the College Mission



#### Online Sections Fall 2006-Fall 2020







#### **Growth in Sections**


Hybrid sections represented nearly 3.5% of all sections in Fall 2007 and grew to represent over 5.5% of all sections in Fall 2019






100% Online Student Enrollments Fall 2006-Fall 2020

Growth in Student Enrollments (duplicated)












### Distance Education: Instructor Training

#### Pre-pandemic

March 2019- February 2020

- 160(duplicated) faculty trained
- 45 trainings online and in person
- 52 hours online and in person
- 13different workshop topics





## Distance Education: Instructor Training

#### During the Pandemic

March 2020 - February 2021

- 1,100(duplicated) faculty trained
- 290 trainings online
- 340 hours online training
- 25 different workshop topics









## Fall 2020 Special Populations 100% Online Student Success




### During the Pandemic: Student Retention
