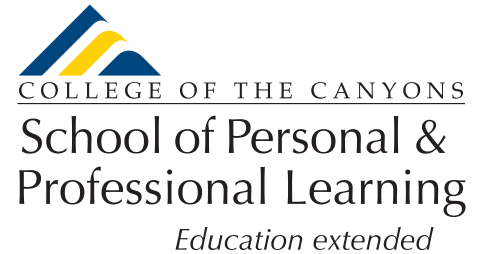

- ▶ **NC.PHOT-050 FUNDAMENTALS OF DIGITAL CAMERA EQUIPMENT:** Explores proper procedures and practices for basic operation of digital cameras, lenses, and storage media for photographic images. *It is recommended that students provide a digital camera capable of fully manual exposure and adjustment.*

- ▶ **NC.PHOT-051 FUNDAMENTALS OF PHOTOGRAPHIC EXPOSURE:** Introduces fundamental principles of manual photographic exposure. *Recommended Prerequisite: NC.PHOT-050*  
*It is recommended that students provide a digital SLR camera capable of manual camera control.*

- ▶ **NC.PHOT-052 FUNDAMENTALS OF PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPOSITION:** Introduces appropriate aesthetic standards in the composition of the photographic image. *Recommended Prerequisite: NC.PHOT-050*  
*It is recommended that students provide a digital camera capable of fully manual exposure and adjustment.*

- ▶ **NC.PHOT-059 LAB PRACTICES FOR THE DIGITAL DARKROOM:** Apply basic importing, processing, and printing of digital images utilizing photography lab equipment and digital darkroom facilities. *Recommended Prerequisite: NC.PHOT-050*  
*It is recommended that students provide a digital camera capable of fully manual exposure and adjustment.*

- ▶ **NC.PHOT-099 INDEPENDENT PROJECTS IN PHOTOGRAPHY:** Presents an introduction to the photographic industry through project development, encompassing research, drafting a proposal, revision, and completion of individual photographic projects and techniques. *Recommended Prerequisite: NC.PHOT-050, NC.PHOT-051, and NC.PHOT-052*

### Submit an application for admission
