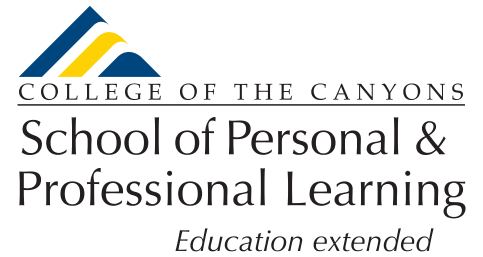


FREE CLASSES

REAL ESTATE COURSES



The Noncredit Real Estate program involves the study of California real estate principles, practices, procedures, and law. Students must successfully complete and pass the Real Estate Principles class (NC.REAL-100), the Real Estate Practices class (NC.REAL-101), and one additional class (of the student's choosing from the approved list) in the real estate department to academically qualify for the California Real Estate Sales license and examination. These classes may also be applied to the academic requirement for the California Real Estate Broker license and examination.**

Classes are FREE • 54 hours • Meet in-person and online • Evening classes

- ▶ **NC.REAL-100 REAL ESTATE PRINCIPLES:** A State of California required course for the Real Estate Sales License exam. **mirrored with credit course REAL-100*
- ▶ **NC.REAL-101 REAL ESTATE PRACTICES:** A State of California required course for the Real Estate Sales License. **mirrored with credit course REAL-101*
- ▶ **NC.REAL-105 REAL ESTATE FINANCING:** This course satisfies one of the California Department of Real Estate Salesperson electives and is required of applicants for the Real Estate Broker examination. **mirrored with credit course REAL-105*
- ▶ **NC.REAL-115 LEGAL ASPECTS OF REAL ESTATE:** This course satisfies one of the California Department of Real Estate Salesperson electives and is required of applicants for the Real Estate Broker examination. **mirrored with credit course REAL-115*
- ▶ **NC.REAL-120 REAL ESTATE APPRAISAL:** This course is approved by the California Department of Real Estate for Sales and Broker's educational requirements. **mirrored with credit course REAL-120*
- ▶ **NC.REAL-130 ESCROW PROCEDURES AND PROCESSING:** This course can be used to satisfy the California Department of Real Estate's requirement for both Salespersons and Brokers. **mirrored with credit course REAL-130*

**Definition for mirrored: A credit and noncredit course with identical course content. Noncredit courses are tuition-free and students do not earn college credits. However, students do have the option to convert noncredit courses to credit using the college's [Credit for Prior Learning Policy](#).*

***Students are advised to check current California Department of Real Estate or other applicable agency academic requirements prior to registering for any to ensure that it satisfies current requirements as a mandatory or elective course for the Real Estate Sales or Real Estate Broker licenses.*

To register for these courses, you must be an existing student or apply to be a student at the college. Please follow the steps below to register for these courses:

New students start here

Submit an application for admission

- Go to: www.canyons.edu/freeclasses
- Click on "Applicants"
- Click on "Go to OpenCCC" when you are ready to fill out the online application.
- Successful application submission will generate an email with the subject line, "Your COC Noncredit Application Has Been Accepted." The email will also include your unique student email, which is also your CanyonsID username.

Upon receipt of the application confirmation email, click on the My Canyons icon at www.canyons.edu. Enter your CanyonsID student email and establish your CanyonsID password.
