

AP 5200 Student Health Services

Student Health and Wellness shall, to the extent feasible, enter into memoranda of understanding, agreements, or collaborative partnerships with existing on-campus and community-based organizations, including rape crisis centers, law enforcement, referral services for assistance and/or make services available to students, including counseling, health, mental health, victim advocacy, and legal assistance, as well as including resources for the accused.

The Student Health and Wellness Center shall provide to the general student body a variety of services and shall implement a comprehensive prevention and outreach program addressing sexual violence, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking. The comprehensive prevention program shall include a range of prevention strategies, including, but not limited to, empowerment programming for the victim, awareness raising campaigns, primary prevention, bystander intervention, and risk reduction. Outreach programs shall be provided to make students aware of the institution's policy on sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking. At a minimum, an outreach program shall include a process for contacting and informing the student body, campus organizations, athletic programs, and student groups about the institution's overall sexual assault policy, the practical implications of an affirmative consent standard, and the rights and responsibilities of students under the policy.
