Update on CCC Science Center Construction

- Completed grading operations on site, dug footings, tied-in to existing utilities, and placed literally tons of steel rebar.
- All this work made way for the concrete footings and grade beams to be poured, which required a large concrete truck to pump the dirt across the entire span of the building.
- Steel has been delivered on site and over the next 2-3 months the structural framework for the 4-story building will start to go up and the outline of the structure will be very visible!
- This 20-month construction project is scheduled to be completed in Fall 2019.




Aerial View of CCC Science Center Construction

- The project is on track for completion early next year!




Aerial View of Valencia Campus Parking Construction



Update on AB19 – California College Promise

College of the Canyons will be receiving **\$898,434** for FY19 and it is ongoing!

- Plans are being developed for expenditure of the funds and, to date, include:
 - ✓ Building on First Year Promise (FYP) to cover enrollment fees for an additional **500** first-time, full-time students who complete the FAFSA or California Dream Act application and commit to full-time and encouraging persistence from Fall to Spring.
 - ✓ Expanding services for Foster Youth, Financial Aid (to process the FAFSAs), Student Business Office, Dual Enrolled (AB 288), EOPS, and the Incarcerated students partnership at Pitchess.
- Details are being worked out quickly to have the greatest impact for firsttime students this fall (registering in 2 weeks) and coordinating with additional financial aid funds being received.
- Going forward, setting up communication with the William S. Hart High School District is essential as we are the focus of the joint fundraising efforts between the WISH Foundation and the COC Foundation to support the promise of a college education for their graduates!
