Online and In person - Express Drop-in counseling is an opportunity to meet with a counselor for a short 10-15-minute consultation to address quick questions. Express Drop-in works on a first come, first serve basis to address questions such as: upcoming registration, adding or dropping classes, grading options, filing a graduation petition, checking progress towards your associate degree or certificate program and/or support with transfer applications. Will you be graduating with your associate's degree this Fall 2021 or Spring 2022 term? If so, stop by either in-person or online express drop-in counseling and file your graduation petition. The petition deadline for Fall 2021 degrees is September 10, 2021.

If you plan to earn your degree Spring 2022, you may file your graduation petition by October 25, 2021 for priority enrollment consideration for spring!

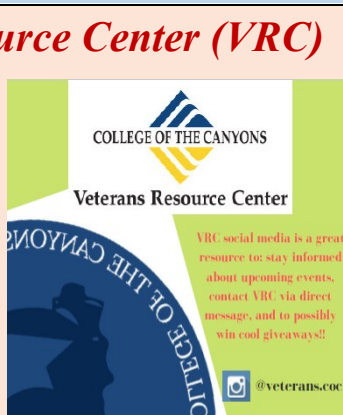

Need Help? Need to talk to a Librarian?

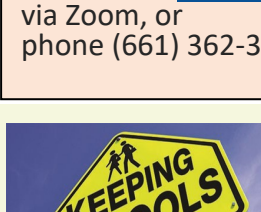
The CCC Library will be open from 9am-12pm and 12:30-5pm Monday through Thursday.
