Counseling

The Counseling Department is here to help you to choose classes that fit best with your academic and career plans. With the Fall 2019 Schedule of classes now available online, and fall registration appointments assigned (check your MyCanyons for your scheduled time), now is the time to drop in and see a Counselor if you are unsure of what to take.

Drop-in counseling is a first come, first serve 10 -15 minute consultation with a counselor. During drop-in we can help you create a one semester educational plan, clear you for pre-requisites and answer general questions related to your academic and career goals. A counseling appointment is required for a full comprehensive

student educational plan. We are unable to develop a comprehensive plan on a drop-in basis, however we can certainly discuss classes for fall registration!
