Summer and Fall Registration have begun! Check your MyCanyons portal for your registration date and time. If you are not sure what to register for in the upcoming terms, stop by our Online Express Drop-in Counseling for assistance!

Express Drop-in counseling is an opportunity to meet with a counselor for a short 10 -15-minute consultation to address quick questions. Express Drop-in works on a first come, first serve basis to address questions such as: upcoming registration, adding or dropping classes, grading options, filing a graduation petition, checking progress towards your associate degree or certificate program and/or support with transfer applications. New Online Transfer Workshops - Visit the Counseling Website to sign up!

Transfer 101: This workshop will discuss important information for students who are interested in transferring to four-year universities. It will detail what the admission requirements are, what are some of the things you need to consider when choosing a four-year university and what are some key recommendations to ensure you transfer successfully. Next workshops will be held on June 9th from 10-11:30 a.m. and June 22nd from 5-6:30 p.m.

Ready, Set, Apply: This workshop is designed for students who have completed 30 units or more and would like to learn more about the application process and timeline for CSU/UC and Private/Independent schools. Next workshop will be held on June 21 from 10-11:30 a.m.

UC Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG): This workshop is intended for students who will be apply for admissions to UC for fall 2022. Topics will include:

- UC TAG (Transfer Admission Guarantee) specific requirements by Campus
- Benefits
- Who is eligible to submit a TAG application

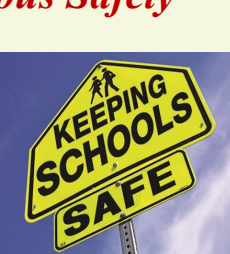
