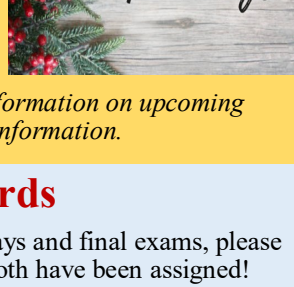

Spooky season has come to an end, and the holidays are quickly approaching. However, before we jump into the most wonderful time of the year, reflect on what we are grateful for (and eat lots of turkey).

A couple of reminders from the Student Business office: November 11th is the withdrawal deadline date that a class can still be dropped with a "W". In addition, in November, we start preparing accounts to issue 1098T Student Tax Forms that will be issued to students at the end of January 2024.

In preparation, students should make sure that we have their correct account information on file by checking their MyCanyons Account to verify or update their address, ensure their legal name matches the name on their social security card and verify that their SSN or ITIN is correct.

This form reports qualified tuition paid within the 2023 calendar year, so if there are any outstanding balances, they will need to be paid prior to December 31st to be included in the form.

Opening Soon - The CANYONS CAFÉ!!

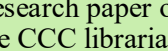

School of Personal & Professional Learning/ Noncredit

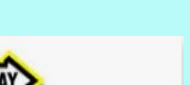
We are here to support students taking Noncredit classes. We are located in the Student Services Center (CCSS-202), room 203, and are open Monday-Thursday, 9am-6pm.
