Online and In-person - Express Drop-in counseling is an opportunity to meet with a counselor for a short 10 to 15-minute consultation to address quick questions. Express Drop-in works on a first come, first serve basis to address questions such as: upcoming registration, adding or dropping classes, grading options, filing a graduation petition, checking progress towards your associate degree or certificate program and/or support with transfer applications. NEW Program Mapper Tool! This is an interactive tool that allows you to view your academic pathway from start to finish. Take some time to explore the required courses needed for your associate degree and/or certificate program. The courses mapped out in Program Mapper list the required sequence of courses based on faculty recommendations within the discipline. **You are encouraged use this tool in collaboration with a counselor.** There are many ways to get to one place and meeting with a counselor will ensure you take the path that best suits your academic, career and transfer goals! 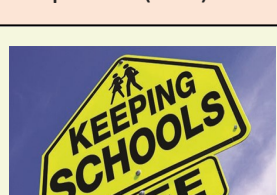
