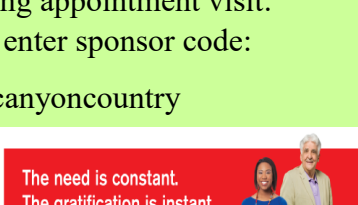

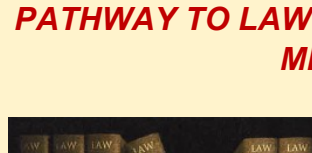
The CCC Library

Everyone is adjusting well to the fall semester here at CCC, and we wanted to say thanks for observing the speed limits on Campus. We also appreciate the students being picked up and dropped off utilizing the pickup/drop off turn out and their rides not stopping along the red curbs, as this keeps traffic flowing smoothly (and keeps students safe).



We also wanted to answer the biggest question we receive at Campus Safety, which is regarding parking passes and our parking machines. As many students who did not purchase semester passes, and choose to utilize the daily parking pass from our machines at the Canyon Country Campus have noticed, our machines are hit and miss as far as working all of the time. Remember this: If the machine in the lot you choose to park in is OUT OF ORDER, you can park in any student space within that lot, and you will NOT be ticketed. Campus Safety will only enforce staff, handicap and fire lane violations.
