Listed below are the recommendations of the Academic Staffing Committee for **NEW** full-time faculty and a replacement LIST FROM Fall 2020. According to the committee's Operating Procedures, we have listed the recommendations for replacement position on a separate list.

The Academic Staffing Committee used a previously approved voting matrix to rank positions presented during the Fall 2020 semester within need categories (**Urgent, Strongly Recommended, and Recommended**). Positions are **alphabetized** within each category. Positions presented in Fall 2020, and positions on the list for the past three years have all been integrated within the rankings such as the rankings are for **ALL** positions regardless of when they came before this committee. Positions that are new to this list are in **BOLD**.

In making these recommendations, the committee sought the input from department chairs, deans, and related District offices. We examined the individual proposals merits, as well as how closely the requests aligned with the overall goals and mission of the District.

Recommendations for new positions will "sunset", and are removed from the recommendation list AFTER three years if not moved to the Board of Trustees for Authorization to hire.

Per our committee operation procedures and guidelines, we conduct a call for new faculty positions each Fall semester. Departments with positions placed on the list Fall 2019. were welcomed to return to the ASC to make another presentation.
