



AP 2105 Election of Student Member

Reference:

Education Code Section 72023.5

- I. Election Procedures
 - A. The student member shall be elected by a plurality vote of those voting in a regular election of the student body.
 - B. All members of the student body may vote.
 - C. The election will be conducted during the spring semester and will be completed in time for the student member to take office on June 1.
- II. Recall Provisions
 - A. The Student Member may be recalled in an election conducted in the same manner as the election to office.
 - B. An election will be called upon presentation to the CEO of a petition signed by at least 20% of the students enrolled at the time of filing the petition.
 - C. No recall election will be held if the petition is received within 30 days of a regularly scheduled election for student member.
- III. Vacancy
 - A. Upon notice to the Chief Executive Officer of the District that a vacancy has occurred, the Chief Executive Officer of the District shall, within 10 days, call a special election.
 - B. No special election will be called if the vacancy occurs within 30 days of a regularly scheduled election for student member.
 - C. The office shall become vacant if the student member becomes ineligible for the office, resigns, is recalled, or dies.
