



AP 5210 Communicable Disease – Students

Education Code Section 76403

1. Introduction

- a. The Santa Clarita Community College District (District) is committed to providing a safe and healthy campus.
- b. The District will cooperate with local health officers by taking any measures necessary for the prevention and control of diseases in students.
- c. The District will comply with any immunization program required by the State Department of Health Services regulations.

2. Scope of Coverage

- a. Per Los Angeles County Department of Public Health updated protocols, vaccines and weekly testing are no longer required, effective March 11, 2022.
- b. Effective June 3, 2022 the requirement for all students to either be fully vaccinated or provide a negative test prior to accessing indoor campus locations or participating in off-site in-person work for the District per Board of Trustee's Resolution 2021/22-04 will end.
- c. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the District strongly encourages COVID-19 vaccinations, boosters, and indoor masking for all students.
- d. Should the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health reinstate vaccinations or asymptomatic weekly testing requirements for Institutes of Higher Education after June 2, 2022, the District will follow said requirements.
