



AP 5220 Shower Facilities for Unhoused Students

Reference:

Education Code Section 76011

1. The district maintains shower facilities for student use on campus that may be used by any unhoused student who is enrolled in coursework, has paid applicable enrollment fees, and is in good standing, in regards to student conduct, with the district.
2. An unhoused student is defined as a student who does not have a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. This includes, but is not limited to, students who: are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelters; have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designated for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; or are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings.
3. Shower facilities are located in the East and West Gymnasiums and are open to use by unhoused students during normal posted open hours.
