BP 5515 - FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS

Reference:

Education Code 76060

In order to assure efficient operation and prudent expenditures of funds under student control, the following policies will apply:

- A. The Associated Students Government will be responsible for the costs of food, lodging, transportation, equipment rentals, supplies, and miscellaneous items for all activities under its sponsorship.
- B. In support of the Intercollegiate Athletic program, playing fields, courts, equipment, game uniforms, officiating costs, transportation, and athletic medical insurance will be provided by the District. Conference dues will be paid by the Associated Students Government.
- C. Per Education Code 76060 the District may provide facilities and utilities for the Associated Student Government to conduct its business subject to such administrative procedures as may be established by the CEO or designee. Such use shall not be construed as transferring ownership or control of the premises. Extra labor charges, including those for security, custodial and maintenance, for student activities events sponsored by the Associated Student Government will be paid by the Associated Students Government.
- D. The Associated Students Government will take necessary precautions to protect District property used in connection with student activities. The Associated Student Government may be held financially liable for District property that is damaged during use in any student activity.
- E. The Associated Student Government (ASG) officers and directors shall be responsible for expending funds in a manner which shall not be detrimental to the best interests of students and/or the College.
- F. The ASG shall not engage in deficit spending and will maintain a fund balance for use by the following year's ASG.
- G. The ASG shall honor past commitments and MOU's made by past student governments. With mutual consent such agreements can be reconsidered.
