

If you are looking for a healthy and nutritious snack for the holidays! The No Bake Protein Balls are great. The recipe calls for unsweetened peanut butter, vanilla protein powder, chai seeds, and flaxseeds to give you the protein source you need.

Step-By-Step Instructions:

- Spread oats onto a small baking sheet and toast them at 350 degrees F for 10 minutes.
- In a microwave-safe bowl, add peanut butter and warm it for 20 seconds.
- Stir in sweetener and salt. Add toasted oats, protein powder, chia seeds, flaxseed, and coconut flakes. Let mixture cool completely. Stir in chocolate chips. Refrigerate the mixture if needed before rolling into balls.
- Roll mixture into balls about 2 tablespoons in size. Place no-bake protein balls in an airtight container and store in the refrigerator. Enjoy it within a week.



Stocking Stuffers and Under \$25

- \$39.99 A flexible and customizable racetrack system that keeps kids engaged for long stretches. The cars are AA battery operated, so they run on the track but do not draw power from it. Great for little ones who enjoy designing their own layouts. Only two cars are powered. Other themes such as dinosaurs are also available.



K-Brands Auger Drill Bit Set – \$23.99 A helpful gardening tool that makes planting faster and easier. Fits standard drills and is well reviewed. This loosens soil for easy planting. Go slow because if you hit a root or rock, it can bind and kick a little.



Gifts Under \$150



Yamaha GL1 Guitalele - \$108.89

A compact hybrid of guitar and ukulele that is easy for beginners and portable. A unique gift for anyone interested in learning music. Think of it as a small guitar with a softer island style sound. Many people do not even know this category of instrument exists.



YOWHICK Smart Home Projector (1080P) -

\$109.99 A budget friendly projector for occasional movie nights or gaming sessions. While high end laser projectors cost much more, this unit and many others offer Wi-Fi and Bluetooth and provide a simple and affordable theater experience. For a few more dollars you can find a 4K version too. Read reviews and watch YouTube videos before you purchase.

BeaverBot Cardboard Cutting Tool - \$208.99

A safe kid friendly cardboard cutting tool that opens up a wide range of craft projects. It is essentially a mini scroll saw designed so you cannot cut yourself. Works best with thin cardboard such as shoe box material.



Snowie Little / Snowie Max Snow Cone Machine - \$194.35

Classified Senate uses this exact machine for snow cone events. It makes incredibly fluffy snow, even in winter. It includes sample syrups and cups and uses regular ice cubes. Smart and Final carries additional syrup options.



Govee Permanent Outdoor Lights Pro (100 ft)

- \$279.99 These are expensive, yes, but fanatic led color adjustable lighting. When it's not the holidays you can change it from multicolor to a warm white mode to make your home more welcoming and safer. If you want to make it look even better, you can get cable covers and cut them to the length between the lights like this example from lowes.
