MUSIC-118B	Popular Songwriting II	The current business environment for Music continues to emphasize the importance of being a DIY artist. One of the most lucrative areas of the music industry is derived from songwriting. In my years of teaching Pop Songwriting I have often had students express to me their desire to have a 2nd level of Songwriting so they could continue growing their songwriting “chops”. In the past those students often audited the course a second time. Now they can grow further individually and mentor incoming songwriting students. Having a recording studio also allows for the original works to be documented to grow their portfolio.	W. MacPherson	TBD
MUSIC-126B	Pop and Jazz Theory II	Having a 2nd level of Pop and Jazz Theory gives students additional time to review what they learned in the first level and build on advanced concepts in level 2. These theory courses are closely aligned with the Pop Songwriting courses by teaching the methods of how chord progressions work in Pop and Jazz and how melodies emerge from those progressions.
