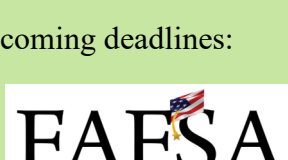
Financial Aid

The CCC Library is open Monday-Thursday, 9am-5pm. Come visit us in Quad 3, room 301!



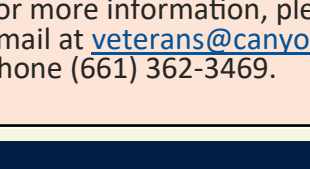
Services include computer and wi-fi access, printing, comfortable study tables and chairs, and of course, BOOKS (including textbooks).
