Counseling

Are you prepared and ready for Fall registration? If you have any questions about coursework necessary to meet your Certificate, AA/AS, AA-T/AS-T and/or transfer requirements, stop by Express Drop-in Counseling. We have counselors available on a drop-in basis to assist you.

Express Drop-In Counseling - This is a short 5 -10 minute session with a counselor designed to support students on a first come, first serve basis to address quick questions such as: summer registration, adding or dropping classes, grading options, filing a graduation petition, checking progress towards your associate degree or certificate program. Are you concerned about your Spring 2020 grades? Moving from the face to face learning environment to the remote/online learning environment has definitely been a transition for many. If you struggled with coursework in spring and did not pass your courses, connect with a counselor during Express Drop-In and we can discuss your options with you. You may be able to petition for an "Excused Withdrawal" or request a "Withdrawal - Removal."

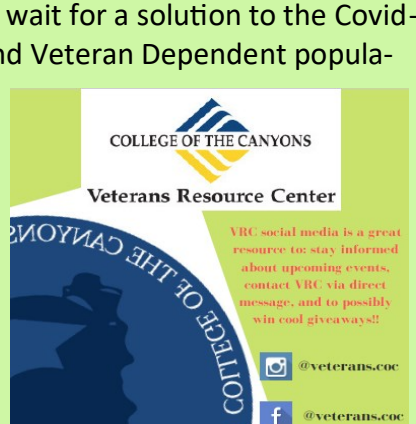
Monday - Wednesday: 9:00am - 5:00pm.

Thursday: 9:00am - 11am and 12:00pm - 5pm.

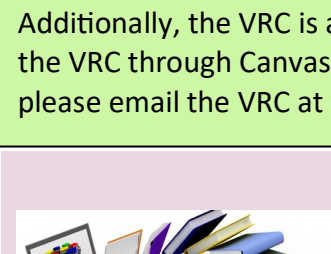
Note the remote VRC will be closed from 11:00am -12:00pm on Thursdays for an office meeting.

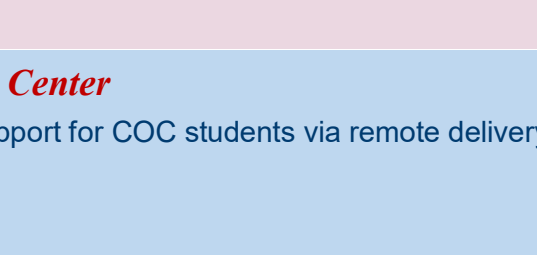
TLC - The Learning Center
