The Learning Center (TLC)

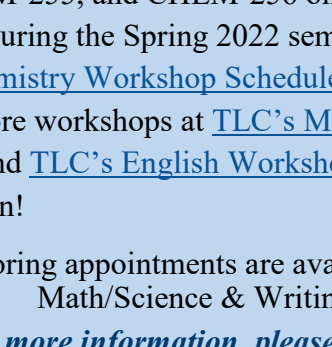
The Learning Center (TLC) is a FREE tutoring resource which provides assistance to current COC students seeking to supplement classroom instruction to reach their educational goals.

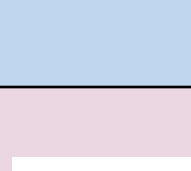
