Associate in Science Degree: Architectural Drafting and Technology

The Architectural Drafting program is designed to prepare students for careers in industry as drafters or related occupations, and/or transfer to a four or five-year Architecture program. Architectural Drafting technicians are in short supply, affording many employment opportunities for qualified individuals. The program provides students with entry-level skills and knowledge in the fields of computer and architectural drafting including techniques such as clarity, line weight expression and accuracy. Competencies include knowledge and skills for preparing CAD/BIM generated 2-D drawings and 3-D models, current practices in construction technology, and fundamental architectural design and space planning skills. Students should consult with the department chair and a counselor when planning to complete the degree for more information on university admissions and transfer requirements.
