Certificate of Specialization: Emergency Medical Technician

Prepares students for certification and employment as an Emergency Medical Technician, including emergency department clinical and ambulance ridealong. Health clearance and background check required prior to start of clinical rotations. Upon successful completion students are eligible to take the National Registry EMT examination. The course meets the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) National EMS Education Standards (DOT HS 811 077A, January 2009) May be repeated if used for legally mandated training.

Certificate Student Learning Outcome:

Students will be able to demonstrate proficiency in EMT skills and knowledge as required by state and local regulations.
