



Resolution of No Confidence in Trustees Sharlene Johnson, Fred Arnold and Darlene Trevino

WHEREAS, the Associated Student Government (ASG) of College of the Canyons (COC) has the responsibility to advocate for and represent the voices, needs, and interests of the student body; and

WHEREAS, the ASG recognizes that collaborative governance among the Board of Trustees, administration, faculty, staff, and students is essential for campus stability, transparency, and the continued success of the students; and

WHEREAS, the students of College of the Canyons deserve leadership that values student success, wellness, and an inclusive and stable campus climate; and

WHEREAS, the actions of Trustees Johnson, Arnold, and Trevino have only contributed to division and mistrust within the college community; and

WHEREAS, upon their election to the Board of Trustees, neither Trustees Johnson, Arnold, nor Trevino have made efforts to directly engage with ASG outside of scheduled Board of Trustees meetings, ultimately displaying a lack of dedication to collaborative governance,

WHEREAS, Trustees Johnson, Arnold, and Trevino have demonstrated a lack of knowledge and understanding of higher education systems and governance, which is vital for effective leadership and decision-making at College of the Canyons; and

WHEREAS, undermining the opinion of the shared governance not only damages trust among employees but also diminishes students' confidence that their concerns and perspectives will be valued at the decision-making level.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Associated Student Government (ASG) of College of the Canyons (COC) formally issues this Vote of No Confidence in Trustees Johnson, Arnold, and Trevino, recognizing their failure to demonstrate consistent collaboration and honest commitment to the well-being of students and the college; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is directed solely at the governance actions and decisions of Trustees Johnson, Arnold, and Trevino in their role as board members and is not intended as a personal judgment of them as individuals outside their roles; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution be shared with the Board of Trustees, college administration, and the broader college community to call attention to the urgent need for leadership accountability and a renewed focus on the stability and success of College of the Canyons students.
