Rebranded the Honor Grove as Leisure Lawn. Some other things aside from the free hot dogs are volleyball, horseshoes, etc.

Partnered with ICC on many of the events this semester like NAIA for example.

The vibe is not the same due to the lack of student involvement with clubs and students.

It is not sustainable for staff to be so involved and would like to involve students more to incorporate things like bounce houses and music.

Event next week is the last one for the semester and they would like to partner with ASG in addition to some Spring semester events.

They would like to create a full agenda with ASG for the 2026/2027 school year.

The Week prior to finals is suggested as a good date to collaborate on an event which is the first week of December.

200 frozen hot dogs and chips are already in supply for the event.

Collaboration efforts would assist to increase student participation.

The energy as well as the marketing from ASG would be a few ways they are interested in collaboration.

Free stuff is always good to bring in people for an event as well as music.

Planning this event can include games and not necessarily an agenda for the event.

Bringing more awareness to outdoor activities, like Dodgeballs, are also something that Recreation Connection has available.

Canyon Country campus event collaboration would entail more support needed.

Promotion and clubs to sponsor tables for the first week of December is what is being asked of ASG.

The duration of the event is discussed and in the past 3-hour time blocks was the time of the event.

11 am until 2 pm is the time of the events in the past.

Having the ASG help with the manpower would help and could hold the event from 9:30 am until 2pm potentially.

Recognition is huge for Recreation Management and would like to involve ASG for future events.

The event cost is about \$400 per event.

Eventually, they would like to hand this off and create an annual event the college holds.

Still in need of purchasing buns for the upcoming event.

Will revisit the Spring event dates to collaborate with Recreation Connection.

Hoping to have the dates for the potential Spring during the winter ASG training.

If you are hosting an event, promote the event as the students are 50 % online.
