Tiered awards for grants range from \$250 through \$1,000

May 15<sup>th</sup> is the deadline for clubs to submit for ICC points.

Total amount to be awarded is \$10,000.00.

A stipulation to the allowable expenses may be given when approving a grant.

Society of Physics and Engineering submitted 3 separate grants.
