Background:

Beginning in 2026-2027, the Inter Club Council will be implementing a new club status category that will be replacing the ICC Incentive Points program. Instead of earning incentive points for different activities, clubs meeting certain requirements will be placed in a new “in good standing” category that will allow them to be eligible for various club privileges. While the original goal of the ICC Incentive Points program was to reward clubs for their active involvement, it has become a very cumbersome job for both clubs and ASG to keep track of club points. Requirements:

 - Need to submit minutes, attendance sheet, or photo for each meeting and flyers or photo for each event
- Submit rechartering forms by November 15th
- New clubs – submit by March 15th
- 7 student members
- At least 1 full-time employee club advisor

Privileges:

(Pending submission of rechartering forms)

- Ability to fundraise
- Use of campus facilities for meetings & events
- Establish an account with ASG and Foundation
- Travel off-campus/hold off-campus functions
- Establish a my.canyons.edu club email account
- Apply for Matching Funds (pending ASG grant restrictions)
- Funding for food for a club meeting or event (once per semester – up to \$75.00)
- Club promotional items (once per year – up to \$200.00)
- ASG Grant eligibility – additional requirements include:
 - Must have held at least 4 club meetings and 2 events per semester
 - Must have been an active club for at least 1 semester
