3.1 Information: Club Accounts Procedures & Policies

<u>Background:</u> Clubs will be provided an overview of the procedures and policies for accessing their club funds.

Melinda is here to introduce herself as the accountant for clubs.

Accounts for clubs may be either in ASG or Foundation.

How to access club funds:

- If the account is active, you must first approve the expense at the club meeting.
- Complete the reimbursement form and include the original receipt and the minutes

from the meeting.

Melinda is in the Student Center, 102 in Campus Life & Student Engagement.

Fundraising must go through the Foundation if non-profit and for tax purposes must go through the Foundation.

Fundraising has different processes based on the type.

Reimbursement process is 3 to 4 weeks for the Foundation.

If approved, you may transfer funds from Foundation to the ASG Club account.

If a club wants to sell a certain item during multiple events, a facility request and food permit would be required.

Advisor must complete with 1-week advance notice.

Facility request- confirms the location of the event and the food permit is submitted only if food will be served during the event.

For additional information reach out to Melinda or the front counter has an up-to-date list of the funds for the club accounts.

ASG grants- if a club was awarded last year, you may follow up with Melinda to get the details on the acceptable expenses for grants.

Facility requests must be done by the advisor.

Credit card payment is not yet acceptable through ASG.

Foundation allows credit card use for donations- create a Venmo type of account for club through Foundation.

On the advertisement, clarify the acceptable forms of currency is okay to use during the event.

A Cash box is available through Campus Life upon request.

Fundraising activities notification is done when fundraising for another entity.

Non-profit organizations must be done through the Foundation Department.

Melinda is available to make an appointment with her or to just drop in.

3.2 Information: NEW ICC Points Tracking System

Background: Starting October, ICC points will be tracked using a new method where a single document shared between the club and the VP of ICC will be used to keep track of all activities and ICC Points.

COST:

Start on your Canvas for clubs and you will see tables under the assignment for ICC points. At the bottom, you will see the points you may earn.

To earn ICC points, you will list the activity under the box for that month along with the number of points earned.

You will then share the link with Chelsea for her to then be able to make comments on the submissions.

For agendas and minutes, clubs may either send the pdf or screenshot when submitting for points by clicking submit in canvas.

The meeting minutes would be under the activity table.

You may download the document, then share the collaborating link with Chelsea.

Additional rows are available if needed.

Microsoft Word is preferred when submitting points.

This will eliminate the need to submit points separately.

Update sheet with points as soon as possible.

Try to get ICC points submitted during the month that it was earned.

Once the link to the canvas assignment has been sent, resubmitting will not be needed.

Start submitting points in October for the new ICC points process.

The sheet will be cumulative throughout the school year.

The form may be shared with other club members.
