3.1 Action: Approval Change Club Status for Theater Club

Background:

Theater Club was placed on probation for failing to meet the minimum Inter Club Council Meeting attendance in Spring 2024. The probationary period will end on September 21, 2024. Theater Club would like to make a case to change the club status to be in good standing and ask to be removed from probation.

Probation Penalties:

- Club funds are frozen except for payment of outstanding debts.
- Use of all campus facilities except for designated meeting rooms is forfeited.
- A club on probation is ineligible for A.S.G. Matching Funds and is ineligible to submit a budget request for the A.S.G. annual grants process.
- A club on probation may not vote on Inter Club Council matters.
- A club on probation is ineligible to earn Inter Club Council incentive points.

The ICC Representative would not show up repeatedly last semester. To rectify, the President is willing to take the place of the club's ICC representative.
