Background: To become a chartered club, there are requirements and forms that clubs will have to meet and submit before they are approved to become an official club on campus.

Chartering paperwork is due by November 15th for clubs.

Forms include information of club members.

Membership must be uploaded with member names and COC ID number.

Constitution for clubs includes details on elections and responsibilities.

Example of the constitution and required information is on the website.

If there have not been changes to constitution since last year, upload the constitution as is.

Advisor Agreement form must be submitted by all advisors.

Club information forms will be used to add information to Canvas for the most updated information.

Clubs must be in attendance for ICC meetings- 4 additional meetings this semester.

Must attend at least 3 of the ICC meetings.

If you cannot attend, please reach out to Chelsea of Kelly to let them know as well as find an alternative for the meetings if possible.

Background: Chartered clubs can receive ICC points to demonstrate their club activity throughout the semester. By collecting points, clubs can redeem them for incentives that can

benefit and bring positive experiences to their organization.

This information will be posted on the website for the college.

If a club attends all 5 ICC meetings, extra points will be given.

Points redemptions are also reviewed.

Matching Funds up to \$200 is one of the incentives for point redemption.

If a club misses an ICC meeting, the club will lose 300 points.

ASG grant application is another incentive through points.

Competitive yearly and no guarantee you that clubs will receive the grant but should save 400 points to apply.

Meetings with your club will also earn ICC points - upload the meeting minutes along with club names to receive minutes.

The ICC Points only carry over from Fall to Spring.

Deadline to submit points will be the last day of each month.

For September, points from the Summer should be uploaded to Canvas.
