What are the differences?

Clubs/Organizations (Chartered vs. BITE Club)

A club at College of the Canyons is a student organization centered on shared interests (cultural, ethnic, religious, educational, honorary, philanthropic, or social) that is recognized by the ICC, ASG, and Campus Life & Student Engagement, requiring a full-time advisor, at least 7 members, and annual paperwork. Clubs choose to be either Chartered or BITE: Chartered Clubs must attend ICC meetings and submit a constitution, but are eligible for ASG funding, fundraising, grants, and ICC points/incentives. BITE Clubs skip ICC meetings and have fewer requirements, but cannot hold off-campus excursions, receive any funding, or earn ICC points/incentives.

Alliances

These groups are centered on shared identities and affinity within a community, functioning as inward-facing, open support groups. They are organized by faculty and staff but shaped by student input, and operate without a formal governance structure or chartering process. Despite this informal structure, they remain eligible for ASG funds and often include other employee groups serving as advisors or leads. Participation in these groups is not incentivized, yet they are integrated into broader institution-wide support programs, such as student success teams.

Our student support programs offer a range of resources, including academic tutoring, mental health and wellness counseling, mentorship opportunities, and financial aid guidance. By fostering a caring and inclusive environment, we empower students to build confidence, develop resilience, and reach their full potential.
