► NC.BUS 203 COST ACCOUNTING

Recommended Preparation: BUS-202 or equivalent
Focuses on managerial and cost accounting. Covers types of cost, elements of costs, cost behavior, variances for labor, materials overhead, indirect expenses, allocation of cost to by-products, standard cost and budgets.

► INTERMEDIATE ACCOUNTING NC.BUS 204

Recommended Preparation: BUS-202 or equivalent
Provides complete analytical application and an advanced review of assets, investments, financial statements, income taxes, liabilities, stockholders equity, revenue recognition, operating and capital leases, asset acquisition and leases.

Upon completion of the two-course sequence students will be eligible to receive the Essential Accounting Skills Certificate of Completion.

Submit an application for admission

- Go to: www.canyons.edu/freeclasses

- Successful application submission will generate an email with the subject line: "Your COC Noncredit Application Has Been Accepted." The email will also include your unique student email, which is also your CanyonsID username.
