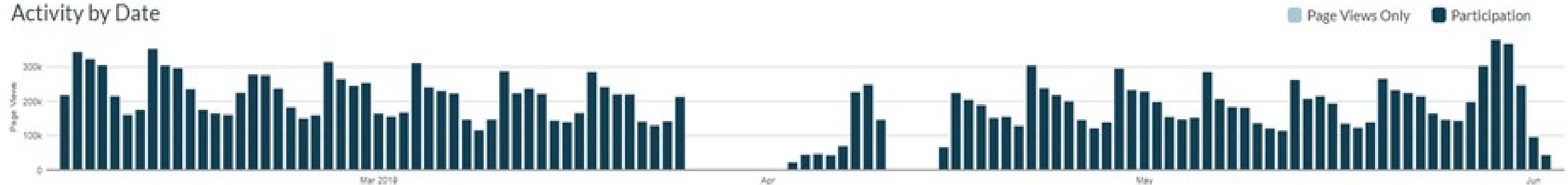

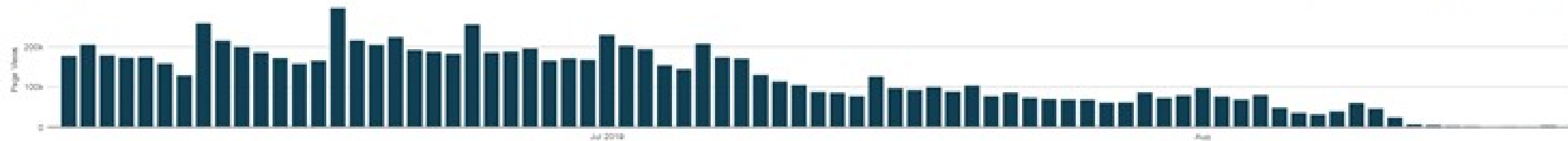

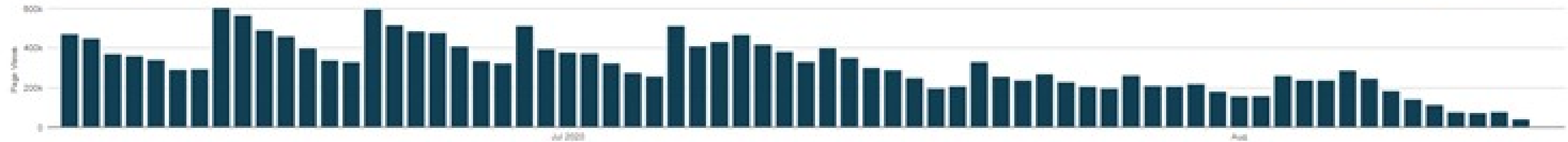

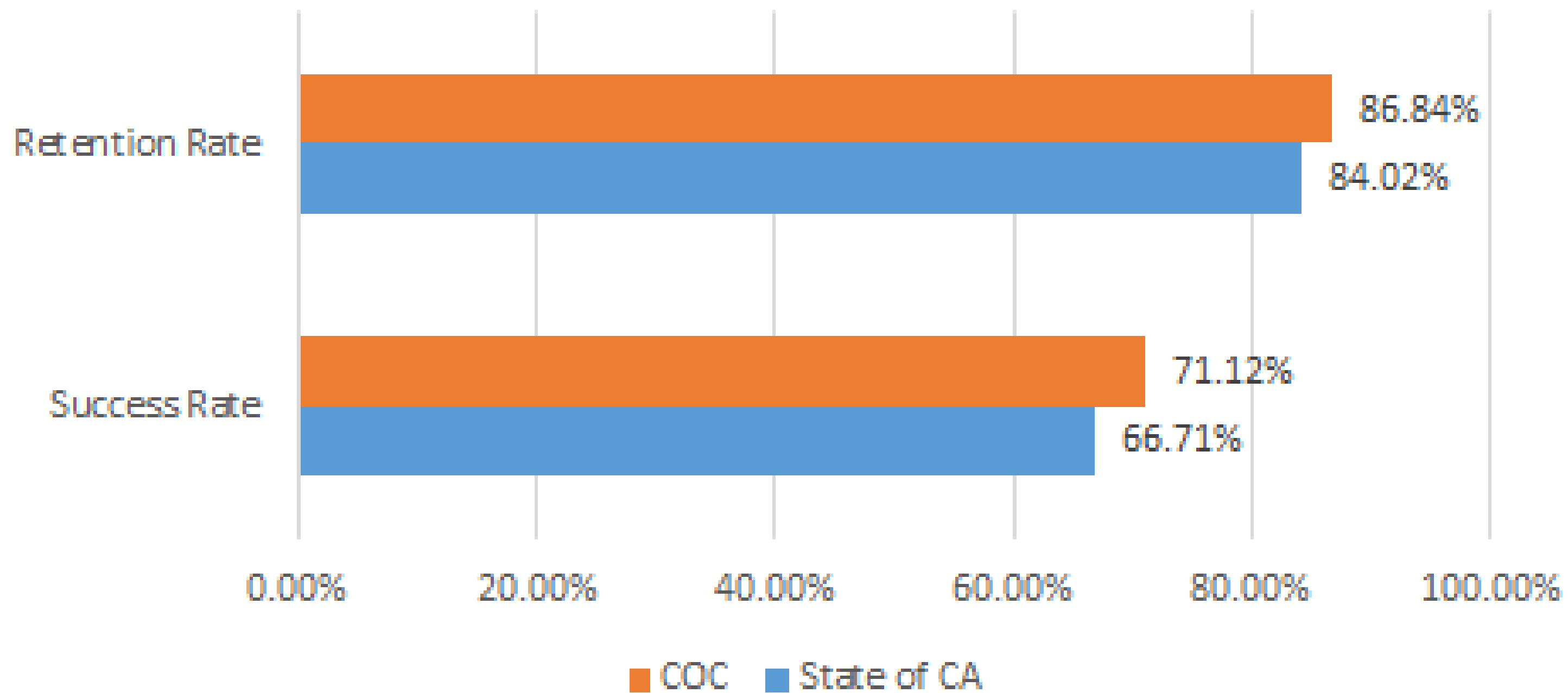

Fall 2019

Student Survey Data

- The unduplicated student headcount for 100% online classes rose to over 5,800 students in Fall 2019
- Top reasons for taking online classes:
 - Convenient schedule
 - Helps with work-life balance
 - Comfort with technology
- Nearly 60% of student respondents would pursue a 100% online degree pathway if available
- 81% of students are satisfied or very satisfied with the quality of online classes at COC

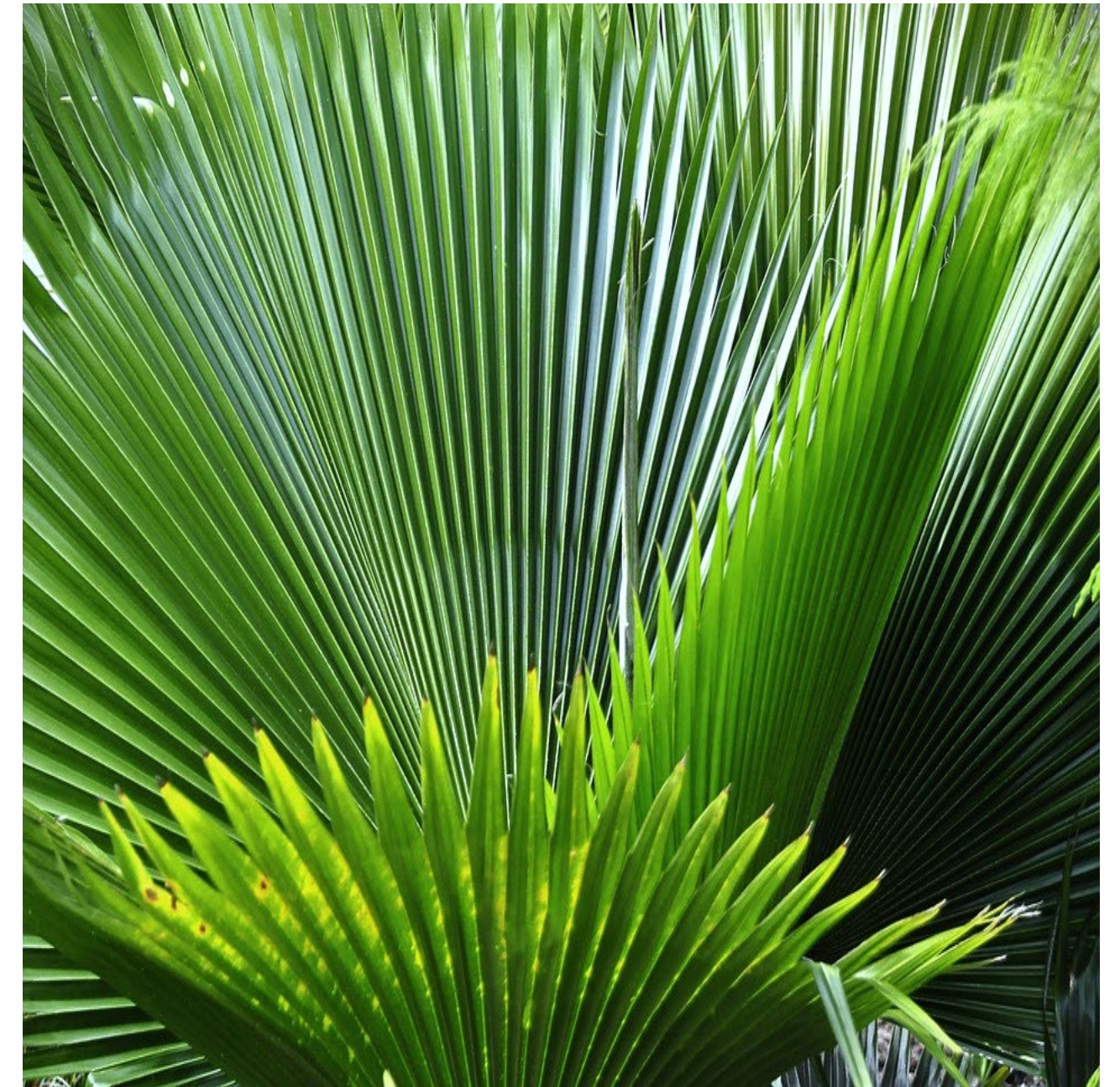
Preparing for the Shift

- Spring 2020 - Trained over 300 faculty during the week off in preparation for shift to instruction at a distance
- Number of Online Ed workshop offerings increased by 400%
- As of 8/7/20:
 - 66% of instructors are fully certified to teach online
 - 1% of instructors are fully certified to teach online
 - 33% not yet certified*



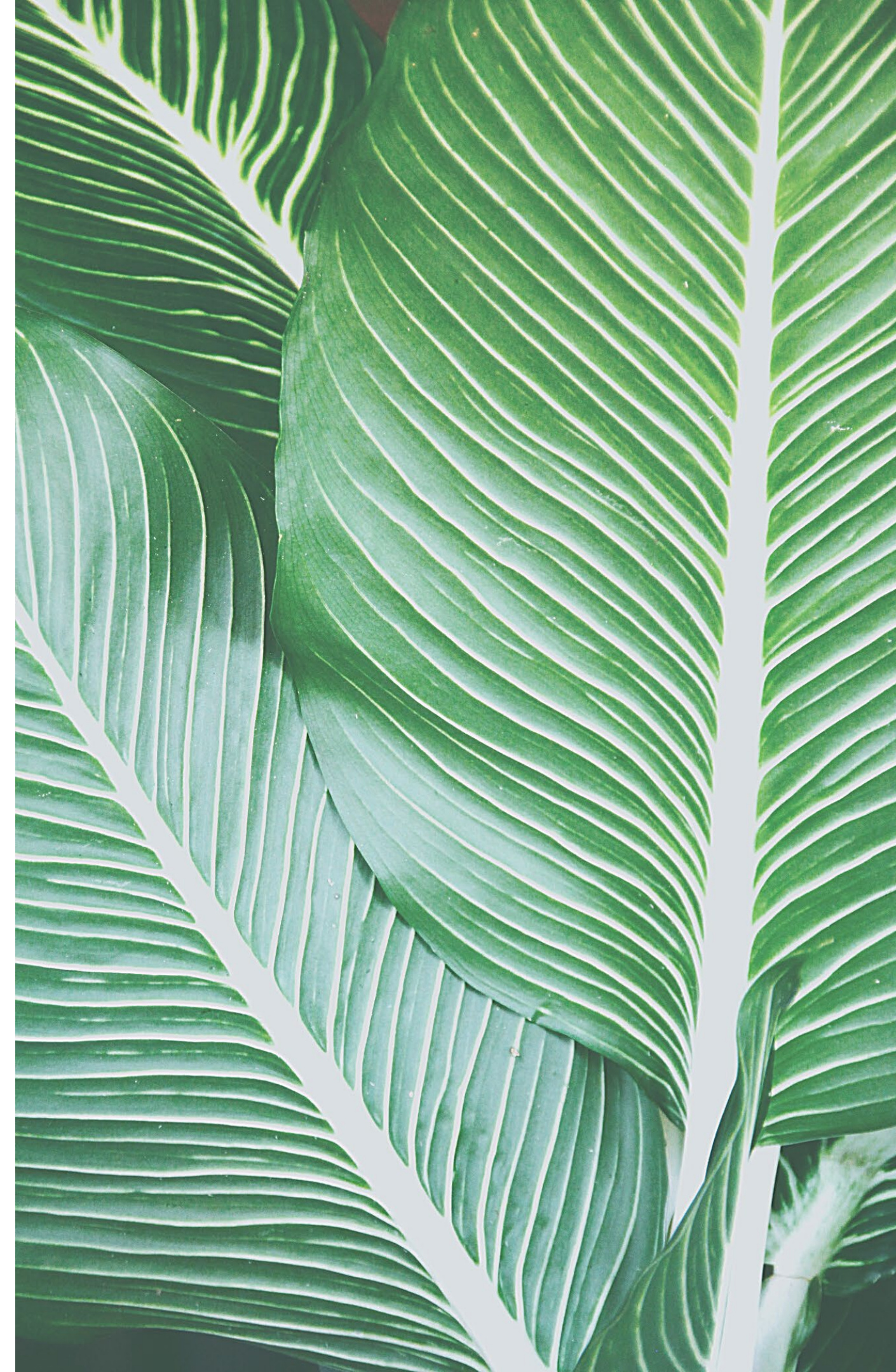
