This two-course certificate examines the impact of trauma on children and youth and trains individuals who work closely with children and youth to identify trauma and determine appropriate behavioral interventions.

▶ **NC.VOC-040 AWARENESS AND IDENTIFICATION TRAINING**

Provides students with the knowledge and skills needed to identify signs of trauma in a professional and/or personal setting and how these experiences can impact behavior.

▶ **NC.VOC-041 INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION TRAINING**

Provides students with the knowledge and skills needed to utilize appropriate behavioral interventions, including prevention techniques, in a professional and/or personal setting when working with children and youth impacted by trauma.

### Submit an application for admission
