I hope that you had a wonderful and restful weekend. As promised, here is the requested information/timeline for the expansion of curriculum to support the evolving health sciences and needs in the SCV.

Based on high regional labor market need projections, the following programs confer to participants upon successful completion a livable wage:

Proposed Program	Average Income (Los Angeles County)	Accreditation Agency	Credit or Noncredit
Physical Therapy Assistant	\$58,000	Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE)	Credit
Diagnostic Medical Sonography	\$91,000	Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP)	Credit
Cytotechnology Technician	\$73,000	NAACLS (like our MLT) or Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP)	Credit
Anesthesia Technology	\$42,000	Note that only on program exists in the state, Kaiser Permanent in Pasadena	Credit
Massage Therapy	Varies - does not confer a livable wage as most workers are independent contractors	N/A	Noncredit

We will commence working on viability proposals for these programs after engagement with our advisory boards, in an effort to get the necessary curriculum developed with the goal of beginning these programs during Fall 2020, when we will be in full swing with the new science building at CCC.
