1. Sandy Caroll (Nursing/Health): Sandy came to COC in 2006 as an adjunct and within a few months was hired on full time as a Nursing instructor. The Nursing Dept. congratulate Sandy on her retirement but are sad to see her go. She has been a great contribution to the department. **Motion** to bestow Emeriti status for Sandy Caroll by Rebecca Eikey, seconded by Ambika Silva. Unanimous. Approved.
2. Vincent Devlahovich (Geography/Geology & Earth Science): Vincent has worked closed with underrepresented students at the Hart District at Golden Valley and Canyon High schools. Vincent served as COCFA Treasurer and President of COCFA President. **Motion** to bestow Emeriti status for Vincent Devlahovich by Carly Gott, seconded by Rebecca Eikey. Unanimous. Approved.
